

Please be aware the Country Park as a natural environment has some hazards present. These include:

- steep cliffs and rock faces
- open water
- wildlife – Ponies / Snakes / Insects / etc.
- vegetation including nettles and brambles

The park is open to the public and is popular with people walking their dogs. This may mean there are dogs off their leads in the park.

You should be aware the park is accessed by motor vehicles therefore caution should be taken especially when crossing the road or car park.

Every effort is taken to keep the park clean and tidy. Unfortunately there is the possibility of fly tip at the park which may on occasion lead to being waste present.

Safety tips

Weather

As the park is in an exposed location sun cream should be worn in the summer / warm clothing worn in inclement weather.

Refreshments

Although refreshments are available at the park for part of the year, it is recommended you ensure drinks are available.

Supervision

Young children should be supervised during the activity. It is recommended you familiarise yourself with landmarks of the park to agree meeting points for older children which may not be supervised.
